AGM

NATIONAL SEMINAR ON AUTOFOCUS 2009

Madras Institute of Technology Alumni association, Bangalore Chapter and MS Ramaiah Institute of Technology, Bangalore organized a one day National Seminar on Automotive Technologies – Current trends and Future Perspectives, Autofocus 2009 on 23 Oct 2009 at HAL Convention Center, Bangalore. Around 100 participants from various industries, R&D institutions and academia participated in the event. The seminar was inaugurated by Dr VRS Natarajan, CMD, BEML Ltd, Bangalore. The welcome address during the inauguration was given by Shri V Gopalakrishnan, President, MITAA-BC while Shri P Rangaswamy, Chairman, Organizing Committee gave a bird's eye view about the seminar. Dr Muralidhara, HOD, Mechanical Engineering Department, MSRIT proposed the vote of thanks. There were three technical sessions during the seminar which were as follows,

★ SPONSOR



Shri G. Viswanathan, T1668/Aero, Director (Retd) – ISRAD/ISRO and Adjunct Professor, Aryabhata Research Institute for Observational Sciences, born in 1945 at Chittoor in Andhra Pradesh, graduated in Physics from Madras University & after obtaining his DMIT in Electronics and Telecommunications Engg from Madras Institute of Technology in 1967

worked on design and development of Avionic packages for IAF at Aeronautical Development Establishment (ADE) of DRDO for two and half years, before joining ISRO in 1970 at Thumba Equatorial Launching Station (TERLS, now a part of VSSC), as a Radar Engineer. He was responsible for the design and development of tracking Radar systems for satellite launch vehicle missions from India's Space port viz. Sri Harikota (SHAR). He later on initiated the development of PCMC radar systems as a joint development between ISRO & BEL to support PSLV mission. Thereafter, he was the project Director for the Establishment of the MST radar system at Gadanki near Tirupati as a major Scientific Facility for atmospheric research in India. Indian MST radar system happens to be the second largest such facilities in the world. He was also co-investigator for the ground validation of the tropical rain fall measuring mission (TRAM), especially for the space borne precipitation Radar (PR), along with the Japanese space aerospace agency. Later he was responsible for the design development and commissioning of the state of art Doppler Weather Radar System for IMD as an inter agency project between DOS & DST. Based on technology transfer from ISRO Radar Development Unit (ISRAD), headed a team of Radar system professionals in realizing Tracking & Weather radar systems for national development, including the next generation tracking radars for the GSLV Mk-III through technology support to L&T. He is a fellow of IETE & a member of a number of professional societies in India & abroad including IEEE. He has published more than 25 Technical & scientific papers in national & international journals. After superannuation from ISRO in 2007, he is currently the adjunct professor at Aryabhata research Institute for observational sciences, Nainital, where ST radar is being established by DST. He is also a member of the committee on technology vision for Ministry of Earth Sciences and Chairman of the sub-committee on atmospheric technology. He was awarded the IETE – IRSI award for excellence in Radar systems in 1992. With his leadership, ISRAD received the first team award instituted by Astronautical Society of India, for the development of Doppler weather radar system. He was felicitated by IAF & Met Society in Feb 2008

for his outstanding contributions in space & aviation meteorology. He has recently (on Aug 25, 2009) received the ISRO Merit award from the Hon Prime Minister of India Dr Manmohan Singh for his contributions towards atmospheric and weather Radars. ★ EMINENT MITIAN



Prof. Dr. P. Mannar Jawahar, T 24209/Auto, currently the Vice Chancellor of Anna University Chennai, was born in a small village called PALAMEDU near Madurai. After his schooling

and B.Sc course at Madurai, he joined the prestigious Madras Institute of Technology for his Undergraduate Engineering Course in Automobile Engineering. He did his M.E. (Mechanical Engineering) at P.S.G College of Technology, Coimbatore. He completed his Ph.D. at I.I.T Delhi from the Department of Mechanical Engineering in "Vehicle Dynamics" area.

Subsequently he did his Post Doctoral Research work at Warsaw University of Technology, Poland. He has devoted himself towards teaching and research, building and grooming young engineers to face the challenges of the modern world, putting in 3 decades of service in the teaching profession in various capacities.

Prof Mannar Jawahar joined Anna University, as a faculty in 1978 and rose to the position of a Professor in 1998. He assumed charge as Vice-Chancellor in June 2008. His vision is to develop Anna University, Chennai into a World Class Institution, renowned for its teaching capability, research tenacity and business acumen. His mission is to disseminate high quality technical education among the youth and inculcate values and ethics.

Even at the very young age of 39, his leadership qualities were recognized and the University bestowed on him, the Headship of leading the Department of Automobile Engineering. He was Head of the Department of Automobile Engineering at M.I.T campus of Anna University for 3 tenures and was Head of the Department of Production Technology at M.I.T for a span. During his tenure as HOD, he was instrumental in creating SEVEN new laboratories worth Rs.5 crores, Automotive

Electronics Lab (1999), Embedded System Lab (1999), Automotive Electrical Testing Lab (2002), Automotive Engine Calibration Lab (2002), Modern Automotive Components Lab (2008), Modern Engine & Vehicle Testing Lab (2008), Modelling and Simulation Lab (2008). As an academician, he exulted as an active researcher interested in inventing things valuable to the common man. He is actively involved in research and has produced six Ph.D.'s in Engineering.

He is an examiner of Doctoral Thesis in various Universities and External Examiner for a number of Ph.D. examinations.

He has about 16 papers to his credit in International Journals, 20 papers in National Journals and more than 70 papers in National and International Conferences. He has written two books in Engineering Discipline.

Prof. Dr. P. Mannar Jawahar is a pragmatist and a reformer. During his term as Director, Centre for University-Industry Collaboration he was responsible for the Placement & Training Activities at Anna University. He was also instrumental in starting the novel and innovative programme called Tamil Nadu State Level Placement Programme (TNSLPP) which is beneficial for the students studying in all the Self-Financing Engineering Colleges throughout Tamil Nadu. He promoted the concept of 'Dream Job' which has provided opportunities for nearly 600 students who have received highly paid job offers, with salaries ranging from Rs. 4 lakh to Rs. 17 lakh per annum. He has been providing encouragement and support for all students, particularly the students from rural backgrounds, some of whom seem to have a marginal disadvantage over their urban counterparts, in terms of their communication ability.

During his tenure he also organized 'Employability Skill Development' programme to the students of affiliated colleges. He has organized training for CTS recruits at Anna University benefiting the faculty and students to the tune of Rs. 1.1 crore. A humanitarian by nature, Prof Mannar Jawahar has organized socially relevant training, to help and assist underprivileged youth in the locality. On several occasions he has given invited talks in "All India Radio and T.V." on a variety of subjects, towards popularizing Engineering

principles, especially on topics related to Automobile, Railways and Placement.

The growing popularity of this University in providing quality education has created a great demand overseas. He has initiated a number of MoUs between Anna University and foreign Universities like Osaka City University, Maastricht University, and University of Joseph Fourier, France.

He has visited several countries and has participated in a number of International Academic and Industrial Forums. He is a member of various professional bodies including SAE, ISTE, ISNDT, ISME. He is a Fellow of Institution of Engineers (India) and also a Chartered Engineer.

Prof Mannar Jawahar is an institution builder and a leading light. He has held various administrative and academic posts at Anna University.

He has served as an Expert Member in Departmental Promotion Council for Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC), Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), in selection / promotion committee for DRDO, in inspection committee of AICTE, Examiner in State Public Service Commission of Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka. At present he is a selection committee member for national organizations like ISRO, DRDO etc. He is also Advisory Council Member of SISI, expert member of Tamil Nadu State Council of FICCI and expert member of Madras Chamber of Commerce.

Humaneness is his characteristic feature. A man of discipline, Prof. Dr. P. Mannar Jawahar, with his serenity and tranquil personality, accomplishes herculean tasks in an affable manner. He is benevolent and at the same time an excellent task master. He is a skilled administrator. Simplicity and integrity are the hall marks of his success. He is easily approachable and highly creative. He inspires confidence and trust in his peers and treats every individual with due respect.

He is blessed with his wife Jewelcy and they are blessed with three sons Nishant, Nitin Prashant and Nirmal Joshua.

○ BOOK RELEASE

Our Patron Sri C.R. Subramaniam, former C & M D of Bharat Electronics Ltd., has written a book "Chronicle of a Navaratna : the BEL Story". This was released in Bangalore on 01-11-2009 by Dr. C.N.R. Rao, National Research

Professor and Chairman of the Advisory Council to the Prime Minister. The book traces BEL's history from its birth in 1953 till the day it attained the status of a Navaratna company 25 years later. It gives an insight into the way the Government learnt to run a public sector enterprise. He has written about how BEL overcame obstacles and evolved as a major electronic Co. meeting the needs of the Defence and Civil sectors. The gathering on the occasion was addressed by Dr. V.K. Educational Assistance Programme, An appeal to all members

Our Alma mater 'MIT' is an inseparable part of all MITians. It is the heartfelt desire and earnest endeavour of every alumnus to give back something substantially to his/her Alma Mater. Quite often, he/she is not clear as to how and in what way it can be done. We are sure, similar sentiments will be prevailing with and going through the minds of many of our members.

For a long time MITAA-BC was of the opinion that it should extend some form of assistance to the alma-mater. Initially it planned to donate books to the library and later made some initiative to build a book bank. However, after MIT becoming a part of Anna University, these assistances lost their relevance. Hence it has been decided to create a fund to provide financial assistance to needy and deserving students studying at MIT. You may be aware that two of our members have been funding the tuition fees for two students in MIT for the past few years, on a specific request from Parent Chapter, which in turn had received the request from the Dean. The Parent Chapter and the Singapore Chapter are funding two students each. This would be a recurring feature and presents an opportunity for us to give back to our Alma Mater something that will benefit the students and the Institute. Keeping this in mind, our executive committee formed a sub-committee to go into all aspects of such a fund. They submitted their report, after studying all aspects involved. This has been approved by the Executive Committee and later by the AGM on 29.07.2007.

Briefly stated, this would be a Refundable Educational Assistance to needy students, who would be identified by the Dean, MIT and the Parent Chapter. Certain criteria for eligibility, like should be a full time student of MIT for any of the courses offered by MIT, should not be employed anywhere, should have a family financial background that deserves assistance and should have an academic performance deserving assistance as per assessment by the Dean of MIT. This assistance will be in the form of interest free loan for the student. The idea behind making it refundable is that the fund will be available to more students on rotation and that the student who benefits will take it seriously and will help in funding more students.

Ideally for such schemes, a corpus fund should be created and payment should be made from the interest earned thereon. In order to create such a Corpus Fund, it is proposed

1. To approach our members and other interested and philanthropic persons for donations to be collected throughout the year, as an ongoing programme.
2. A certain percentage of money earned through conducting of Seminars and Workshops be transferred to this Corpus fund.
3. An annual voluntary donation from every member of the executive committee and office bearers.
4. These funds will be maintained separately but will very much form part of the funds of the Chapter.

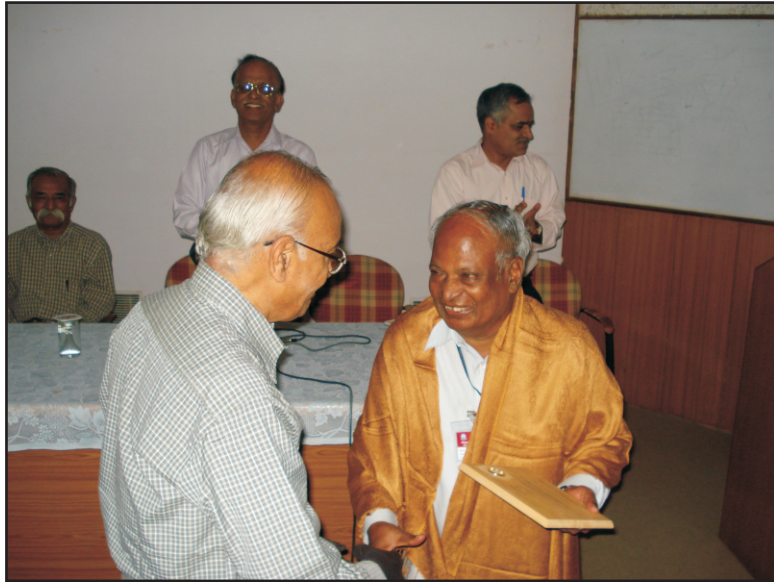
It will also be ensured that the student would be in regular contact with MITAA-BC and keeping the Chapter informed of his/her contact address, email ID and phone number regularly.
